**INVITATION FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (EOI)  
FOR  
Consultancy Services for Planning, Detailed Design and Procurement for Environment  
Management Services Component for four Cities in Sri Lanka (Trincomalee, Dambulla,  
Kurunegala and Ratnapura)**

**(Package No. SUDP DPC EP 01)**

1. The Government of Sri Lanka is negotiating a project loan with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for financing the proposed Sustainable Urban Development Project (SUDP), which is envisaged to enhance service delivery by providing priority infrastructure and institutional strengthening of selected urban local authorities ((i) Trincomalee; (ii) Dambulla; (iii) Kurunegala; and (iv) Ratnapura; of Sri Lanka. Ministry of Megapolis and Western Development is the executing agency (EA) and will implement the project through the Project Management Unit which is already established under the Ministry and presently implementing the Strategic Cities Development Programme. (SCDP)
2. The rationale of the project is to develop urban nodes outside Colombo with growth potential in priority economic corridors and important nodes across the country. The funding would provide for transformative investments to aim at creating livable prosperous communities that leverage industrial / economic linkage. The physical infrastructure interventions in SUDP will include works identified under Environmental Management Services component in the four project cities mentioned above.
3. This invitation for EOI relates to recruitment of a consultant for Environmental Management Services component of the project. This would be to undertake the initial diagnosis studies and preparation of Master Plans for solid waste management and urban drainage including flood control, preparation of feasibility reports and detailed designs and estimates for priority works of the Master Plans identified to be taken up under the Project in the above mentioned cities. Some sewerage works may also be required to be designed based on the requirements assessed during preparation of drainage master plan. The consultants shall also prepare the bidding documents and assist in procurement of the works and goods under the Project component.
4. The EA intends to engage a reputed firm with international exposure and relevant experience in accordance with ADB's Guidelines on the Use of Consultants. A Quality and Cost based (QCBS) mode of procurement will be adopted using a 90:10 weightage for technical and financial scores respectively.
5. The firm would be required to deploy a team of international and national experts to:
  - (i) Undertake necessary sector specific initial studies, surveys and investigations, conduct feasibility studies, prepare master plans, prioritize development interventions, prepare detailed engineering designs and drawings, assist the EA in complying with the social and environmental safeguard requirements, prepare cost estimates and bidding documents, assist in procurement of civil works and goods.

- (ii) Identify the capacity building requirements in operation and management of assets created under this component, design the training module and accordingly train the officials of local authorities and Project Partner Agencies (PPA).

6. The duration of consulting services will be over a period of around 15 months. It is estimated the assignment would cover around 216-person months (pm) of consulting services (International 16 pm and National 200 pm) who would be further assisted by supporting technical (non-key) staff of around 76 months over the 15-month period. The person months are indicative and more accurate person months will be provided in the RFP to be issued to shortlisted consultants.

7. The Environmental Management Services component mainly (but not limited to) covers:

- (i) Storm Water Drainage and flood control;
- (ii) Solid Waste Management;
- (iii) Waste Water Management (Related to above (i) and (ii) sub components)

The investments under environmental management services component will be coupled with institutional strengthening required in operating and management of assets related to the sectors above.

The subprojects would be mainly among the above sectors based on the requirements of each local authority.

8. Reputed Consulting firms – single entities, joint ventures or consortiums – with successful and high standard of achievements in managing time bound externally aided, integrated urban infrastructure programs with expertise in the above-mentioned fields are invited to furnish their EoIs. The Expression of Interest should be supported by details of the firm / firms that include *Name of the firm, Country of origin, Year of incorporation, Experience of working in similar areas for last 10 years, Relevant experience in Programs of similar nature and complexity, Experience of working in similar geographic region or countries, Registration details of the firms and details of key personnel*. GoSL is looking for a firm who has an all-round / overall experience in the sectors mentioned above mainly in:

- Project Development;
- Preparation of master plans for above mentioned sectors;
- Project formulation, diagnosis and feasibility studies;
- Detailed design of components in sectors mentioned above;
- Quantity and Cost Estimates of works;
- Procurement of works, goods and services;
- Financial and Economic analysis of sub-projects;
- Safeguards in project planning and implementation (social and environmental); and
- Institutional development / capacity building in operation and maintenance of assets created under the project.

9. The Expression of Interest should clearly reflect the experience of the firm in the preparation of above mentioned plans with examples of projects undertaken of a similar nature. Experience of the firms mainly in the above-mentioned subject area for the last 10 years would be considered for evaluation. (i.e. assignments completed on or before 01 July 2008 will not be considered for evaluation). Client certificates on successful completion of projects shall be submitted and will be considered for evaluation. Experience details should cover the population of the cities covered in the assignment, person months of key experts / non-key experts in the assignment, value of consultancy services completed and the year of completion etc. to facilitate comprehensive evaluation. The format of submission of EoI is published along with the EoI notification in the Ministry's project website and CSRN section of ADB website to be used for submission (The submission need to be strictly in the EoI format published and not in any other format). The submission of EoI is offline and should be made in hard copies to reach the address indicated in paragraph 11 below.

10. The PMU reserves the right to accept or reject any / all Expressions of Interest and cancel the notification without assigning any reason.
